

5 Next Steps

Moving forward through the planning and design process, the following is a summary of the next steps in the Kleinburg-Nashville Focus Area Review:

- 1. Refine the Plan;
- 2. Present the work-in-progress to Council;
- 3. Refine the Plan and establish the implementing policy framework and mapping;
- 4. To obtain direction on an ideal development strategy that will:
 - Update the land use, urban design and development policies in the Kleinburg-Nashville Community
 Plan for the lands identified as "Rural Area" and the "Nashville Core Area" in terms of conformity with Provincial, Regional and City plans and policy context;
 - Prepare a Public Realm/Streetscape Strategy for the lands identified as "Rural Area" and the "Nashville Core Area";
 - Develop a Parks/Open Space Strategy that will provide for the protection, restoration and enhancement of the area's natural heritage and open space system;
 - Maximize use of existing municipal infrastructure; and.
 - Consider innovative sustainable development and environment strategies.

- Prepare the urban design and architectural control guidelines, including Heritage Development Guidelines for Nashville Village and Conservation Strategies for built heritage and cultural landscape resources;
- Present Draft documents to Council, staff, stakeholders and the public;
- 7. Refine all documents and present at the statutory Public Open House; and,
- 8. Refine all documents and present the final documents at a statutory Public Meeting and Council presentation.
