Improvements are coming

The City of Vaughan is undertaking important municipal infrastructure improvements to various stormwater management facility and outfall locations. Stormwater management facilities are designed and built to collect rainfall and surface water runoff.

As part of the Capital Works Program, the City is overseeing the construction of a new stormwater management facility at Saddle Tree Crescent Outfall, and the retrofitting of existing stormwater management infrastructure at Accumen and Harmonia ponds. These enhancements support the City's continued commitment to ensuring long-term sustainability of municipal infrastructure.

Timelines

The detailed design phase is now complete and the tendering process to retain a qualified contractor is underway.

Construction is expected to begin in the fall of 2022 with anticipated completion by fall 2023.

Scope of Work

In addition to the installation of new stormwater infrastructure, the scope of work includes the cleaning and grading of stormwater management ponds.
