



To help ensure families can safely walk, cycle or drive to and from schools, the City of Vaughan has implemented a new Speed Limit Policy to reduce speed limits **in school zones from 50 to 40 kilometres per hour**.

## **TIPS FOR PEDESTRIANS:**

- Encourage children to always obey crossing guards.
- Pay attention to traffic while walking along or crossing roads.
- Cross at designated crosswalks, crossovers or controlled intersections only.

## **TIPS FOR DRIVERS AND CYCLISTS:**

- Reduce speed in school zone areas, especially in slippery conditions.
- Ensure to give yourself enough time to get to your destination without the need for speed.
- Stop for school buses and be aware of children running in front of or behind buses.
- Obey crossing guard signals and yield to pedestrians.
